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rare wrap in garter stitch

choose from three different tension options to create this easy to knit, luxurious fringed wrap...

essential info

ALL WRAPS MEASURE

Width (approx)	cm	55
Length (excluding fringe)	cm	160

YARN

Use either **RARE EARTH Boucle** or **RARE ESSENTIALS Astrakhan** 50g balls of yarn

Style A (tightest tension) 8

Style B 6

Style C (loosest tension / as pictured over) 4

FRINGES for all 3 styles 2

NEEDLES

For Style A 1 pair 8.00mm (US 11), (UK 0) Knitting Needles or size you require to give correct tension.

For Style B 1 pair 10.00mm (US 15), (UK 000) Knitting Needles or size you require to give correct tension.

For Style C 1 pair 15.00mm (US 19), Knitting Needles or size you require to give correct tension.

For all Blunt ended knitter's (sewing) needle, suitable for making up purposes.



HELPFUL TIP

Whilst knitting these wraps make sure that when you need to start a new ball of yarn you do this at the beginning of a row to prevent creating ugly joins that would be obvious in these open garter stitch fabrics.

WRAP

Style A - Using 8.00mm Needles, cast on 66 sts. Knit in garter st (1st row is wrong side) until work measures 160 cm from beg, working last row on wrong side. Cast off loosely knitways. Using knitter's needle, sew in all loose ends. Make **fringe** as follows.

Style B - Using 10.00mm Needles, cast on 55 sts. Knit in garter st (1st row is wrong side) until work measures 160 cm from beg, working last row on wrong side. Cast off loosely knitways. Using knitter's needle, sew in all loose ends. Make **fringe** as follows.

TENSION

A tension square is required before knitting any of these 3 wrap styles. Work your tension squares as follows -

Tension for Style A - 12 sts and 20 rows to 10 cm over garter st, using 8.00mm Needles. To work *approx* a 15 cm x 15 cm tension square, using 8.00mm Needles, cast on 18 sts. Knit 30 rows garter st. Cast off loosely knitways. See following # Tension Info, below.

Tension for Style B - 10 sts and 17 rows to 10 cm over garter st, using 10.00mm Needles. To work *approx* a 15 cm x 15 cm tension square, using 10.00mm Needles, cast on 15 sts. Knit 26 rows garter st. Cast off loosely knitways. See following # Tension Info, below.

Tension for Style C - 7 sts and 11 rows to 10 cm over garter st, using 15.00mm Needles. To work *approx* a 15 cm x 15 cm tension square, using 15.00mm Needles, cast on 11 sts. Knit 16 rows garter st. Cast off loosely knitways. See following # Tension Info, below.

TENSION INFO Please check your tensions carefully. If your tension square is larger than 15 cm x 15 cm then you have may less sts and rows to 10 cm than stated, so change to smaller needles. If your tension square is smaller than 15 cm x 15 cm then you may have more sts and rows to 10 cm than stated, so change to larger needles (refer to a needle size chart for guidance).

The best results can only be achieved if you take the time to establish the correct stitch tension as stated. The needle sizes mentioned above are merely a starting point. Be aware that if your tension is not correct dimensions and yarn usage will all be significantly effected.

ABBREVIATIONS - garter st = every row knit, st/sts = stitch(es).

CARE INSTRUCTIONS - Do not press. Follow washing and care instructions on ball band.

Style C - Using 15.00mm Needles, cast on 38 sts. Knit in garter st (1st row is wrong side) until work measures 160 cm from beg, working last row on wrong side. Cast off loosely knitways. Using knitter's needle, sew in all loose ends. Make **fringe** as follows.

FRINGE - Make 22 fringes by the following method. Wind yarn round a piece of cardboard 20 cm long and cut along one edge. Then take 15 strands of the cut yarn for each fringe, fold yarn strands in half and draw the looped end through work, draw loose ends through the looped end and pull tightly to form a knot. Repeat evenly placing 11 fringes across the cast-on edge and 11 fringes across the cast-off edge of Wrap. Trim ends of fringes as desired to even up ends.
